


Arne Jacobsen designed Cylinda-line in 1967 as a complete collection in perfect harmony. His work was inspired by the Bauhaus movement and he played an important role in Danish modernism. He was a master of details and his persistence in the development process resulted in a unique set of tableware, in steel with a prominent Bakelite handle. His minimalistic design is still synonymous with sophistication.

One of Arne Jacobsen's very first *Cylinda-line* sketches was the *AJ-teapot*. After the sketches were completed, prototype models were made out of wood and it was up to the workshop to determine how to produce the design in stainless steel. The project took three years to complete. The handle was subsequently changed, however the rest of the design remains true to Jacobsen's original sketches.




